Business arising from the previous minutes:

- Steve Glennon raised the issue of using the top car park at Crookhaven Heads as an RV overnight stop. He said that this proposal had been squashed by council.
- One of our members raised a query regarding the Penguin Head lookout. They said that there had been some work done to widen the pathways and clean-up some of the vegetation but there need to be more done. There was a suggestion that another letter be sent regarding this.

Business Arising from the Correspondence:

- Jack Kerr informed the meeting that normally the President or Vice President attends the CCB meetings at council.

Reports:

- **Treasurer-** The bank balance as at the 31st October 2017 was \$26,200.58. There was no Market money as the markets had not been held yet. Sec: Daniel Sandstrom
- **Market Co-ordinator** –We have a few food stalls coming the November Markets. The tablet that was found at the last markets has been returned to its owner.
- **Bugle** – There have been over 600 copies distributed.
- **Chamber of Commerce** – There is no report. Burrirdise Banners are being removed and the Surfing Titles ones are being hang in their place.
- **Men's Shed** – There have been four meetings. The shed is being slowly sorted out. Lunch is provided.

- **Skate Park** - A question was raised regarding the graffiti on the walls of the Skate Park. Ray said that he had been informed that when the Skate Park was erected there had been an anti-graffiti coating painted onto the cement.

General Business

- A concern has been raised about the Council trucks and other vehicles parking on the footpath on Park Row. This makes it very difficult for Pedestrians and people on motorised scooters. It was suggested that a letter be written to council regarding this. It was also suggested that the Police should be called.
- Alan Liebert raised a concern about the surveys. He said that some people had still not received their surveys. There have been 4000 printed and 2700 have been distributed. Anne Hollis-Coates asked if the surveys that are returned without a name or address on them are still counted. She was told that all the surveys will be counted.
- Alan Pendleton raised a query re Penguin Head Road. He said that it is urgent that Council put a footpath on one side of the road. Steve Glennon also mentioned that the slabs on the footpath on Prince Edward Avenue are lifting,
- Steve raised the possibility of speaking to Council of having an RV Dump site at Ocean Street. He said that the Caravan & Motor Home Club Australia would contribute to the cost.
- Ray said that we have still not heard from Council about the placement of the Doggy Do Bag dispensers being attached to the poles. A letter would be sent to council regarding this.
- Ray Sutton asked if anybody knew of a sign writer. There were suggestions made such as contacting the TAFE or Council sign writers.
- Anne Hollis-Coates raised the objection to Vincentia-Huskisson been classed as the gateway to Jervis Bay. She said that Callala Bay /Callala Beach should be named as the entrance to Jervis Bay.
- Ken O'Day said that National Parks and Wildlife to not contribute to the maintenance to the of the National Parks. But they charged people to use them.
- Steven Glennon mentioned that the Caravan and Motorhome Association has done a brochure which contains information about Shoalhaven Heads, Berry and there is also mention about Culburra Beach.
